Sana – Our 17 Millionth Patient



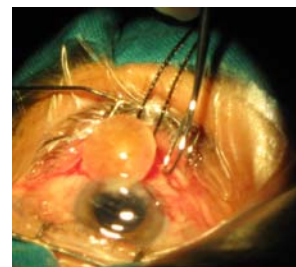
Bringing back sight to Sana's life is a shining success story of LRBT. Sana, a 12 year old girl, was born in a poor family and since both her parents were working in a small factory Sana was handed over to her old grandmother, when she was 22 days old. Upon reaching 3, she was admitted to a government school and continued her studies till she reached class three. During this period her eye sight was deteriorating and by the time she reached class 3, she had become totally blind and had to drop out of school. With her parents not around to support her, Sana was disheartened and terrified about her future. Her old grandmother could not see her in this state and took her to various local doctors, but could not afford the cost of the corneal transplant that they advised..

And then one day hope came flooding back:, Sana was taken to LRBT eye clinic in Surjani Town, where upon examining her eyes, Dr. Haroon referred her to LRBT Free Tertiary Eye Hospital in Korangi. They confirmed the need for a Cornea transplant. As for her grandmother worries about the cost she was told that she will not have to pay a single rupee for the treatment. But the only delaying factor was a cornea donation. Her grandmother's prayers were soon answered and upon arrival of cornea donation from the Eye Bank of Canada, Toronto her cornea grafting took place. Sana was both excited and nervous when her bandage was being removed. Slowly she opened her eyes and her joy at being able to see again knew no bounds. With tearful eyes her grandmother said, "This hospital is a blessing and source of hope for the poor and I will never stop praying for its progress and prosperity." Sana is thankful to the entire team of LRBT and above all its donors for saving her future and wishes to become an Eye Specialist to serve suffering humanity.

Sana is 1 out of 48 fortunate people who have undergone cornea transplantation during the 4th quarter 2009. Out of these, 30 corneas were transplanted at our Lahore hospital while 18 at Korangi (Karachi) Hospital.

To serve the growing number of patients each year, LRBT is continuously expanding its hospitals:

Mandra (Rawalpindi) Hospital Expansion

Work on expansion of Operation Theatre (doubling its size) has been completed in December 09. The cost of project has been funded equally by the Punjab Welfare Trust for Disabled (PWTD) and LRBT.

Gambat (Khairpur) Hospital Expansion



Mr. Justice (R) Shamim Ahmed Sarwana has arranged donations of Rs.2.5 million for the expansion of Operation Theatre and procurement of a Generator at our Gambat hospital. The Generator has been procured and installed. The expansion work is expected to commence by 1st week of February and expected to be completed by August 2010.

Korangi (Karachi) Hospital - New OPD Complex



Construction of the new OPD wing (covered area 14,000 sq.ft.) consisting of patients' waiting area, lecture hall, screening rooms and consultants' rooms, which is being funded by the Bhaimia family, is in progress and scheduled to be completed by June 2010.

- A free eye screening camp was conducted in collaboration with AES Lal Pir. A total of 911 patients were examined, out of which 566 were medicated, 107 were refracted.

Doctors / Paramedical Staff from LRBT Hospital Lahore set up an Eye Stall to educate the visitors about the eye diseases and also carried out refraction.

LRBT signed a partnership agreement with Rotary Club (Karachi South) for providing \$ 56,750 for restoring sight of 2,136 poor patients at LRBT Gambat (Khairpur) hospital & providing 75 Optyse TM Units to LRBT for use at LRBT's Primary Eyecare Centers and Eye Screening camps for early detection of sight conditions. The 2,136 sight restoration surgeries of poor patients have been performed successfully. Distribution of 75 Optyse is in progress.

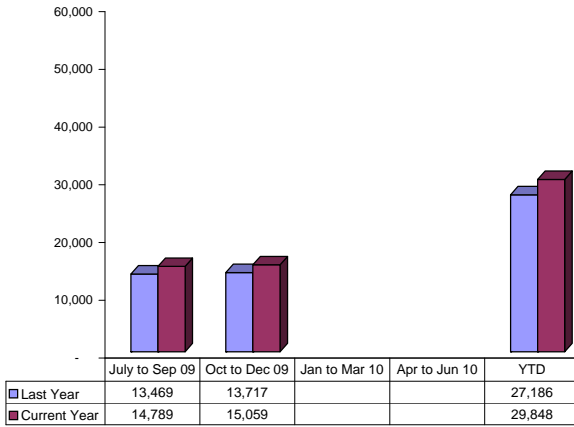

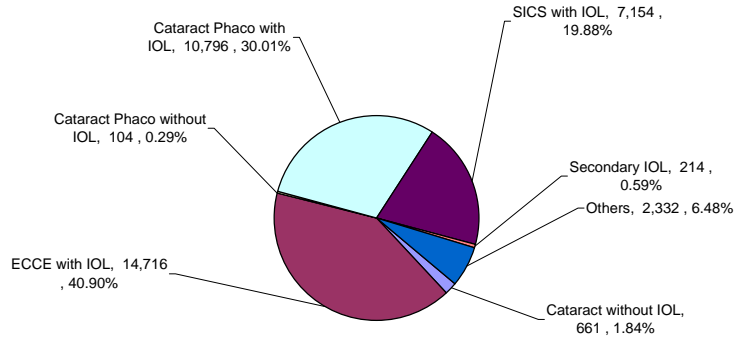
