# SHABBIR KHAN

A STORY OF REKINDLED HOPE

50  
MILLIONTH PATIENT



28 years old and the only bread earner of a household of eight, Shabbir is a fruit seller, particularly falsas. When he managed to get his fruit cart he had high hopes for the future, he was relieved that his father would not have to bear the burden of running the house alone. With 5 younger siblings, they were already too many mouths to feed. Only three of his siblings were in school, the two younger ones stay at home with their mother.

Shabbir still remembers the day he sold his first batch of fruit, the look of pride on his father's face and the tears of happiness rolling down his

mother's eyes. He could finally shoulder the burden of his siblings' education from that day on. Shabbir did not know then that soon he



would be solely responsible for the roof over their heads and food on the table due to his father's rapidly deteriorating health. Shabbir took a loan and got his father examined at a good hospital where he was diagnosed with stage 3 lung cancer. His father a strong self-made man broke down in front of Shabbir upon hearing the news, he refused any treatment and locked himself in his room. The family's grief was palpable, the man who had spent his life caring for his family now had his days numbered. Shabbir's life came to a standstill, he went to work at 6 am and returned at 8 pm, after that he was his father's constant companion. He barely slept at night, having to help his father with washroom runs and trying to make his life as comfortable as he possibly could.

Previously a social person, he became a recluse and cut off ties with all his friends and acquaintances. His father's illness and the toll of being the sole bread earner for his family started to show on his face.

He was so involved in caring for his father that he scarcely noticed that his vision would get blurred at times and as the months passed he was unable to see at all from his right eye and had limited vision in his left. His mother finally convinced him to go to a local clinic and get it checked where he was diagnosed with cataract in both eyes and advised immediate surgery. This felt like the final nail in the coffin, Shabbir felt his life come crashing down around him, he did not know how he would get the money for treatment and without surgery he would surely go blind. His family would have no source of income, no roof over their heads and would have the burden of another family member who was dependent for his every need. His mother was shattered, she prayed with all her heart for their troubles to go away and perhaps it was in answer to her heartfelt pleas that a friend told Shabbir about LRBT Korangi Hospital and its free eye care services for the poor.

Shabbir had a successful surgery and is back at work now, he feels like he has truly been given a second shot at life

# COPING WITH THE EVER-GROWING PATIENT VOLUME

LRBT started off as a small mobile unit in Tando Bago over 36 years ago. Over the years, it has spread throughout the country with 19 hospitals and 62 primary eye care clinics. The journey of growth and expansion continues.

## Rahim Yar Khan | New Hospital

Lack of eye health care facilities especially for the poor are immense because of affordability issues as they cannot visit private clinics due to prohibitive costs.

In the District of Rahim Yar Khan, quality of life for people with threatened or existing visual impairment and their participation in social life and society in general has greatly been impacted.

In order to address these issues, LRBT has embarked upon a venture to construct a purpose built Hospital in Rahim Yar Khan which is planned to be completed in two years.

Construction activity could not be initiated earlier as there were further requirements of the District Authorities that need to be fulfilled. The ground breaking finally took place on 25th June 2022.

LRBT is being provided full financial support for purchase of land and construction of this hospital by a UAE based donor who in the past he had sponsored major renovation and expansion at Khanewal and Gambat Hospitals. This was followed by construction of a new OPD and surgical complex at Lar and presently construction of a new hospital building at Mandra. We are deeply indebted to the family for their unflinching support.

## Mandra

This Hospital is a major unit in our network of 19 hospitals and in addition to receiving patients from its catchment areas, it serves patients referred from our hospitals in KPK where some diagnostic tools and treatment is not available for certain eye ailments. Civil work is progressing ahead of schedule. Brick masonry and plastering work is completed on all floors while electrical, plumbing and tile work is nearing completion. Paintwork is also being carried

out in various areas of the building. Front elevation and major portion of the boundary wall is 95% complete. A lift especially meant for the patients has been installed. We plan to make the OT operational in the first week of July while the OPD and the other areas are expected to be available for the benefit of the patients during the last week of July 2022. The scheduled completion date of this project is August 2022.

### Gambat

Following completion of construction of a new OT having a capacity of 8 sets, the allied services and sterilization areas requiring remodeling and renovation began after Eid ul Fitr holidays and was completed on 30th June 2022. Our surgical services continued unhindered throughout the period of construction so that the people coming to the hospital were not inconvenienced by additional visits.

## PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENTS

LRBT gives credit to its partners for its success and is proud to work with them on ongoing projects:

### Sightsavers



Sightsavers and LRBT collaborated to partner last year under wherein we are required to perform a total of 6853 cataract surgeries at Sibi. This project targets the marginalized, disadvantaged poor populace residing in the peripheral areas of Quetta, Gwadar and Turbat, the southwestern coast of Balochistan, over a period of three years. During the period April - June 2022, 179 surgeries were performed. This

was below the planned target because of reluctance of patients during Ramazan followed by festivities during Eid holidays. The accumulated number of surgeries that have been performed so far under this project totals 2237. We are also in contact with various health authorities to spread awareness about the availability of these services at our Sibi facility.

### Brien Holden Foundation



BHVI and LRBT have teamed up as part of a global effort emphasizing the need to increase

children's access to eye health and continues to provide eye wear to children through "Childrens' Vision Campaign". In order to provide comfort to the parents and families, these spectacles are now being made available at all hospitals. During this quarter, we conducted OPD of 70,386 children of which 6,836 were refracted and 1,681 glasses were provided to them.

LRBT also operates six optical shops at our Korangi, Gambat, Lar Multan Road, Lahore, Mandra and Akora Khattak Hospitals which provide quality eye wear at affordable prices to the people who visit these facilities. This activity has added value as it provides quality eye wear at affordable prices in the premises of the hospitals. Following a decision taken in talks with BHVI, it was decided to add two more shops where most needed. The optical shop at Shahpur Hospital is expected to be operational by the end of this year and the second one in the Rahimyar Khan Hospital in 2024.

### CBM International

Significant progress has been made in the

project which was launched last year for the purpose of strengthening inclusive and quality eye care services in District Rahimyarkhan, Punjab in collaboration with the Government in which LRBT is the implementing partner.

The following milestones were achieved during the quarter under review:

- During the 2nd quarter of 2022, 17,912 people were screened for eye problems. At PECC's, 1406 screenings were performed. In last three months total of 171 persons with disabilities availed eye care services. During the reporting period, a total of 115 cataract surgeries have been performed at THQ hospital.
- The low vision clinic at THQ is fully established and functional from the month of May 2022 and all the remaining LVD charts have been procured. A total of 16 clients were identified, 6 patients have been visited for assessment and 4 patients have received low vision aids.
- At the request of MS. THQ Sadiqabad, the two major ophthalmic equipment's Silt lamp, Autorefracto - Kretometer were procured for eye care assessment at OPD. For this purpose, a special

approval was obtained from CBM. Twenty cataract surgical sets were also provided to the THQ Hospital.

- A total of 2528 school going students were screened at 5 schools, 48 were further referred for refraction and advance assessment while 38 students were given spectacles
- In order to meet accessibility requirements at 24 BHUs and 5RHC's, civil work began during the month of June 2022 and presently at 3 RHCs and 5 BHUs major accessibility activities have been completed while work is in progress in the remaining units which will be completed by the end of July 2022.
- A total of 125 wheelchairs, 225 crutches and about 150 white sticks were procured under the supported activity of mobility aid assistance.
- A two-day consultative workshop on the formation of District Eye Inclusive Health Committee and plan was organized in Karachi on 9-10th May. The report with plan templates were developed by the Consultant and shared with district health authorities for their feedback and inputs. Once the feedback is received, it will be followed by a two-day meeting at RYK with committee members to devise a DEHP. Moreover, the Eye Health Committee and plan will be finalized during two days meeting with DHA in Q3 2022. This plan will be developed by the DHA and will be monitored and implemented at both UC and District level to further strengthen eye healthcare services and reach the marginalized and poorer populations.

### FHF Cataract surgeries



The Fred Hollows Foundation

A "National Sight Restoring Project" under the aegis of FHF required us to perform a total of 2900 cataract surgeries at 5 LRBT designated hospitals from Jan-November 2022. We have conducted 398 sight restoring surgeries during the period under review while a total of 870 surgeries have so far been conducted. The project is progressing satisfactorily and will conclude in November 2022.

## OBAT CANADA



In its effort to relieve poverty in developing nations, primarily in South Asia by providing support to individuals in need through health care, OBAT and LRBT are committed to providing state of the art, comprehensive, quality free eye care in Pakistan. This led to a number of agreements requiring us to conduct cataract surgeries in addition to receiving state of the art ophthalmic equipment.

A generous offer to donate urgently required ophthalmic equipment to LRBT for use at four of its hospitals has been made by Mr. Akber Khimani, a donor based in Canada. We expect the equipment to be available by September this year.

In a related development, we are also required to perform 3643 sight restoring cataract surgeries at our facilities at Arifwala, Kalakalay and Mansehra. This is a six-month project which will conclude in December this year.

### Government of Sindh



Govt. of Sindh graciously awarded a grant of Rs.80 million for the fiscal year 2021-22. In an effort to alleviate curable blindness in the province. We performed 15,009 sight restoring cataract surgeries at all five of our Sindh Hospitals over a period of 12 months. This quarter's target of 3,753 surgeries was attained before the end of May 2022, well ahead of schedule.

We are grateful to the Sindh Government for their continued support.

### A&A Company Formations DMCC- Dubai

In the month of April 2022, 313 poor patients received Avastin injections at ten of our designated hospitals. A total of 4,635 Avastin injections administered over this project period. This project began in May 2021 and successfully concluded in April 2022.

Under an understanding reached with A&A Company, a new project began in May 2022 and shall conclude in April 2023. During the month of May-June, 1,031 poor patients received Avastin injections at eleven of our designated hospitals. A total of 8,683 Avastin injections will be administered over the project period.

### Partnership Agreements

We are grateful to A&A Company Formations-DMCC for their generous support.

### Ebrahim AliBhai Charitable Trust

Under an arrangement with Ebrahim Ali Bhai Trust, LRBT conducts 250 cataract surgeries on a monthly basis at its North Karachi facility. This project was launched in January 2021. During the period under review we conducted 750 surgeries. A total of 4,658 cataract surgeries have so far been conducted under this project. We extend our gratitude to the Trust for their assistance.

### I-Care Foundation



In order to reduce preventable blindness amongst poor and needy males and females, I-Care Foundation entered into an agreement with LRBT in April 2022 under which 306 cataract surgeries were conducted during the period of May to June 2022. The hospital designated for this purpose is our facility at Pasrur.

### Abbott Laboratories Pakistan



An agreement was inked with Abbott Laboratories Pakistan to perform 282 cataract surgeries. We conducted 282 cataract surgeries as planned, in the month of June 2022.

### INFAQ Foundation



INFAQ Foundation has been providing continuous support to LRBT every year by financing the much needed ophthalmic equipment at facilities where they were most required. In this quarter we received an operation microscope and 2 vital signs monitors for our North Karachi Hospital. We are grateful to the Foundation for their unflinching support to LRBT.

contributing member of society. This milestone was featured in all prominent newspapers and social media platforms.








