52 Millionth Patient of LRBT – Asfa Can Go Back to School



While Pakistan was grappling with an uncertain economic and political landscape, the floods in 2022 worsened an already precarious situation. Approximately 1,800 people lost their lives and 2.1 million families were displaced from their homes, and forced to either migrate or continue living in tents or makeshift homes by the side of the road.

2023 hasn't offered respite either: the Pakistani Rupee continues to devalue, with inflation at an all-time high. Furthermore, the legacy damage from the floods continues to play havoc with the food supply. As the common man struggles to survive, little Asfa and her family are trying to brave their way through all these challenges.

Like other children, 7-year old Asfa aspires to do many things: go to school, play with her friends, and run to her father as he returns home from his farm work. But when the rains came, Asfa watched her



family's modest belongings get carried away by torrents. Much of her village in Sanghar was submerged under water and her and other homes were destroyed. Now, her father, Tanveer, is trying to rebuild what they lost, but he dreams of a very different future for his children. "I want them to go to school. I want a better and more secure life for my children."

Living in a joint family, Asfa has two siblings - a sister and a brother. Going to school is something Asfa always enjoyed doing, but recently, she started facing difficulties in reading and writing. Her teacher noticed that Asfa was making

mistakes and seemed unable to focus on or read the blackboard. Asfa's father was informed and advised to get her eyes examined.

Tanveer took Asfa to a nearby clinic where the doctor diagnosed her with corneal opacity in both eyes. This condition could lead to complete blindness if not treated promptly. The doctor also informed Tanveer that the procedure could be done in Karachi and would cost two hundred thousand rupees.

Heartbroken at the thought of his daughter losing her sight, Tanveer decided to ask for help. One of his relatives informed him about the free of cost eye surgeries at LRBT and offered to pay for their travel LRBT Korangi Hospital, Karachi.

Tanveer was nervous and worried – what if they don't offer to help Asfa? But upon reaching LRBT Korangi, he was relieved and happy to learn that not only was the surgery free, the doctors, counselors and staff were also very kind and compassionate. Asfa was evaluated and recommended for corneal transplant surgery. The counselors and staff registered the case and promised the family that the Hospital would get in touch once the LRBT Cornea Department had arranged for a donor-gifted cornea.

As they waited for the hospital to call back, Tanveer started to lose hope. But thankfully, Asfa didn't have to wait too long and they received a call from LRBT Korangi Hospital, and Asfa successfully received a sight saving corneal transplant.

Asfa has since resumed her studies and to the delight of her teachers and family is doing well at school. Her joy has lifted the mood and spirit of the entire family.

"I'm so grateful to LRBT for giving my family this happiness." said Tanveer with a big smile. "May LRBT continue to give the same opportunity to others that it has given to me and my family."

COPING WITH THE EVER-GROWING PATIENT VOLUME

LRBT started off as a small mobile unit in Tando Bago over 37 years ago. Over the years, it has spread throughout the country with 19 hospitals and 55 primary eye care and 5 outreach clinics. The journey of growth and expansion continues.

Rahim Yar Khan | New Hospital



The ground breaking of LRBT RYK hospital took place on 25th June 2022 and completion is expected by June 2024. The project is progressing satisfactorily with 35% completion at this time. The estimated budgeted cost of this project is Rs. 284 million.

The Hospital building's basement slab concrete has been completed and subsequently 40% of the ground floor slab work has also been completed. The remaining ground floor slab formwork is in progress. 40% first floor concrete columns have been formed.

The Doctors' Residences construction is under completion with 4 residences plaster completed and electrical work in progress. Additionally, the ground floor formwork for two residences is also in progress.

This project is being executed through the full financial support for the purchase of land & equipment, construction of this hospital by a UAE-based donor who in the past has sponsored major renovation and expansion at the Khanewal, Gambat hospitals. This was followed by construction of a new OPD and surgical complex at Lar, and a new hospital building at Mandra which was completed in June last year. We are deeply indebted to the family for their unwavering support.

PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENTS

LRBT gives credit to its partners for its success and is proud to work with them on ongoing projects:

Sightsavers



Sightsavers, in collaboration with LRBT, aims to reduce the cataract backlog in order to improve the rates of cataract surgeries by the improving areas of Balochistan. Under a partnership agreement with LRBT, a total of 6,853 cataract surgeries are planned to be conducted at Sibi of the population residing in the peripheral areas of Quetta, Gwadar and Turbat, In south western coast of Balochistan over a period of three years. Starting from January 2023, the service focus will be exclusively on Sibi. During the January-March 2023 period, 82 surgeries were performed. The cumulative number of surgeries performed so far is 4,238.

In a related development, 2,900 sight restoring cataract surgeries have been sponsored by Sightsavers, which are being performed at our Khanewal Hospital during this calendar year. This project is progressing as planned.

Brien Holden Foundation



During the quarter under review, we organized OPDs of 68,714 children of which 5,420 were refracted. 929 glasses are being provided to them under the “Children’s Vision Campaign”.

LRBT also operates six optical shops at hospitals in Korangi, Gambat, Lar, Multan Road Lahore, Mandra and Akora Khattak hospitals in collaboration with BHF, and provides quality eye wear at affordable prices to the people who visit these facilities. Another shop was added at the Shahpur hospital in December 2022. An additional shop will be inaugurated at the Rahimyar Khan hospital when it becomes operational in June 2024.

LRBT and BHF are also collaborating on a research project titled "Effectiveness of Optical Shop Models in Pakistan". This project will run from 1st March 2023 to 30th April 2024. the research study will assess:

- The quality of prescriptions provided by optometrists at the refraction units of identified LRBT hospitals.
- The quality standards of spectacles at the optical workshops of these LRBT hospitals (BHVI vs outsourced optical workshops) and the patients' satisfaction with vision, comfort, price, and service delivery.
- The effectiveness of optical services in terms of quantity, quality and sustainability based on quality indicators.
- The results of the research will provide opportunities to advocate for quality standards of refraction and optical dispensing, and allow improved

planning to strengthen standard refractive / optical services.

CBM International



In collaboration with the Christian Blind Mission International (CBM), LRBT is implementing a multi-interventional Inclusive eye health project: "Strengthening of Inclusive Eye Care Services in Rahim Yar Khan District". The project is funded by BMZ (German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development).

The primary goal of the project, in collaboration with government health departments, is to provide access to improved and inclusive eye health services in the Rahim Yar Khan District of South Punjab. This is being achieved by strengthening ophthalmic services at the primary and secondary health levels, by capacity-building measures for health staff in the region, by introducing government self-help groups and supporting the needs of disabled persons organizations (DPOs), and by systematic advocacy of district health authorities.

During the 3rd quarter of 2022-23, the updates on the project activities are as follow:

- **Eye Screening** - A total of 25,833 people were screened for eye diseases and refractive errors. of these ,38% were men while 62% were women
- **Referrals** - A total of 774 patients identified with eye problems were referred from the primary eye care center to the secondary level for further diagnoses and treatment.
- **School Screening** - Under the School Screening component of the project, a total of 1,979 children were screened during the reporting period. Out of these, 135 children were identified with vision problems and referred to Rural Health Centers for further examination and treatment.
- **Training of Health Staff** - Refresher training of LHS and LHVs in Eye Screening was conducted. A total of 19 healthcare staff were trained on vision screening and identification of eye problems.
- **Eye Care Services Provision** - Under the project, a total of 6,491 spectacles were prescribed. Out of these, 2,506 spectacles were

provided free of cost to deserving patients. A total of 121 cataract surgeries were performed at THQ hospital, Sadiqabad, and 7 low vision aids were provided to deserving patients.

To achieve the cataract surgeries target, a request has been submitted to the National Committee for Eye Health and the College of Ophthalmology and Allied Vision Sciences for the provision of adequate eye health staff at THQ Hospital Sadiqabad.

- **Accessibility measures at health facilities** - The construction of accessible washrooms in THQ hospital has been successfully completed.
- **Provision of essential Assistive Devices** - To empower and support persons with disabilities with independent living and livelihoods, a total of 20 tricycles (mobility aids) were provided to persons with disabilities including 18 men and 2 women. The Assistant Commissioner, RYK also attended the mobility aids distribution ceremony and appreciated the efforts of the LRBT project team.
- **Dissemination of Inclusive Eye Health Materials** - More than 12 thousand brochures, focused on raising awareness of cataracts, refractive errors, and eye health and hygiene, have been distributed in communities and schools. A total of 650 posters have been placed at 29 Health Facilities and 100 posters in local communities by Organizations for Persons with Disabilities.
- **Formation of District Eye Health Committee** - Notification on the formation of the district Inclusive Eye Health Committees has been issued with the approval of the Deputy Commissioner. There have been three committees notified namely the District Inclusive Eye Health Committee chaired by Deputy Commissioner RYK (consisting of 7 members), the Technical Inclusive Eye Health Committee chaired by Chief Executive Officer, DHA Rahim Yar Khan (consisting of 18 members), and the Union Council Inclusive Eye Health Committee chaired by Senior Medical Officer (consisting of 8 members).
- **Celebration of International Events** - During the period under review, different International days were celebrated including International Women's Day, World Glaucoma Day, and World Optometry Day. The purpose was to create

awareness about the importance of eye care and to appreciate health workers for their contribution in making eye care services available.

• **Stakeholders Meeting** - In January 2023, the program team including the General Manager Operations-II, and Program and Finance Managers attended the CBM Partners Workshop in Islamabad. The project progress, challenges, future plans, and CBM Country Strategy planning were discussed during the meeting.

In Feb 2023, the program team including the Consultant ophthalmologist at THQ Hospital Sadiqabad, Program Manager, Program Officer, and Data Entry Operator attended the Project Kick-Off workshop for enhancing optical services in Rahim Yar Khan organized by Brien Holden Foundation and Doaba Foundation in Lahore. They also attended the training workshop on inclusion, held in Lahore.

FHF Cataract Surgeries



The Fred Hollows Foundation

Under an agreement between Fred Hollows Foundation and LRBT named "National Sight Restoring Project", we were required to perform a total of 2,000 cataract surgeries at 4 LRBT designated hospitals from December 2022 - February 2023. The target of 2,000 cataract surgeries was successfully achieved.

In a separate arrangement, FHF required us to perform 2,530 sight restoring cataract surgeries over a period of five months January - May 2023 at 5 LRBT designated hospitals. We have so far conducted 1,512 sight restoring surgeries during the period under review.

Government of Sindh



The Government of Sindh graciously awarded a grant of PKR 80 million to LRBT for the fiscal year 2022-23.

Under this grant, LRBT is required to perform 14,467 sight restoring cataract surgeries at all five of its Sindh Hospitals over a period of 12 months.

A total of 7,233 surgeries were performed, meeting our target for this quarter well before the end of March. We are deeply grateful to the Sindh Government for their continued support.

A&A Company Formations DMCC - Dubai

During the period Jan-March 2023, 1,878 poor patients received Avastin injections at eleven of our designated Hospitals. A total of 8,683 Avastin injections were planned to be administered over the project period. These injections are being administered to patients who are unable to afford this treatment and are being financed by the Company. The project began in May 2022 and shall conclude in April 2023.

We take this opportunity to thank A&A Company Formations - DMCC for sponsoring this project.

Ebrahim Alibhai Charitable Trust

Under an arrangement with Ebrahim Ali Bhai Trust, LRBT conducts 250 cataract surgeries on a monthly basis at its North Karachi facility, which have now been increased to 375. This project was launched in January 2021. During the period under review we conducted 1,000 surgeries. A total of 7,158 cataract surgeries have so far been conducted under this project.

We extend our gratitude to the Trust for their generous assistance.

INFAQ Foundation



The INFAQ Foundation has been providing continuous support to LRBT every year by financing much-needed ophthalmic equipment at facilities where they were most required. A photo coagulator has been approved for our Gambat Hospital, the delivery of which is in process. We are grateful to the INFAQ Foundation for their consistent support to LRBT.

SESSION 2023: An advertisement inviting admissions was published in the local newspaper. Collection of applications and selection process for the Ophthalmic Assistant, Ophthalmic Technician, Ophthalmic Operation Theatre (OT) Technician, and Refractionist courses have also been completed. Presently 34 candidates are undergoing these courses. Classes commenced from 02nd January 2023.

SESSION 2022: Students from Punjab and Sindh completed their academic sessions in December 2022, and appeared for their final exams at the Sohail University. Their results are awaited.

financial needs of LRBT in the service of the visually impaired underprivileged of Pakistan.

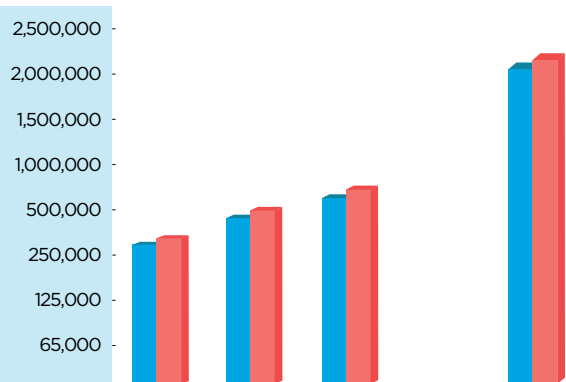

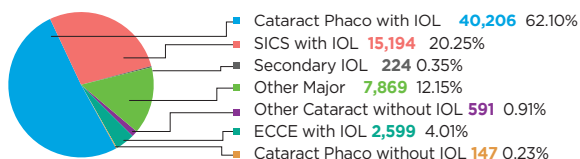
